

## **DEA Selects New Threat4 x-62000 Tactical Headset**

Chicago -December 10, 2011 – After testing and evaluating communication headsets, the Chicago Division of the Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) has purchased the new x-62000 Threat4 tactical headset.

The x-62000 headset has a patented 4 microphone system to provide near 360 degree situational awareness, while providing a very high level of hearing protection (32-39dB noise reduction), and sound localization. The DEA will take delivery of the headsets in early 2012.

DEA has 226 Domestic Offices in 21 Divisions throughout the U.S., and 85 Foreign Offices in 65 countries. When created in 1973, the Drug Enforcement Agency had 1,470 Special Agents and a budget of less than \$75 million. Today, the DEA has nearly 5,000 Special Agents and a budget of \$2.02 billion.
