

96th Air Base Wing at Eglin AFB purchases new x-62000 headset

January 11, 2012 – Threat4 announces that its new tactical radio communications headset, the x-62000 has been selected by the 96 CEG at Eglin Air Force Base in Florida. The x-62000, which merges hearing algorithms and hearing protection technologies to achieve near human ear performance, while maintaining 32dB-39dB hearing protection, will be delivered to Eglin AFB in early 2012. All the headsets ordered will also include Threat4's compatible x-63000 Dual/Tri Radio PTT (push-to-talk), which allows for use on two or three different radios/intercoms.
