I recently had the opportunity to evaluate the Xacore X-62000 series In-ear Digital Radio Headset and X-63700 Single Radio PTT. I evaluated the system using a Motorola XTS 5000 radio. During my evaluation I had the opportunity to use the headset in several situations to include range training, training scenarios, and actual operations. The Xacore headset was a welcome addition to my toolbox. Its lightweight, fully adjustable design uses a mesh headband and additional padding to provide a very comfortable fit over extensive period of time, even under a helmet. The headset provided very effective hearing protection while maintaining situational awareness through the use of Xacore's "Quad-Mic" adjustable Active Listening System. Radio transmissions, transmitted and received, were very clear and understandable, even when wearing a protective mask. The X-63700 Single Radio PTT is an oversized push-button switch with durable aluminum housing. The PTT was very easy to manipulate, even in periods of elevated stress. It includes a Remote Wireless PTT which was a very reliable and durable addition to the Xacore system during the evaluation period. I appreciated the opportunity to evaluate the Xacore system and recommend it to any operator or tactical team.

I reviewed the Xacore X-62000 IN EAR DIGITAL HEADSET WITH BOOM MIC and the X-63700 PUSH TO TALK. I was very impressed with this product. I was first introduced to the Xacore line at the 2010 NTOA conference in Pittsburgh. At the time, I was given a basic introduction to the product, but wasn't able to put it to the test. Now I have. We used the X-62000 for our firearms shoots, flash bangs deployments, and even tried it during our explosive breaching training. During the testing, I found I was still able to hear commands and communicate with my partner and command. It did an excellent job of cutting out the noise from gunfire/explosions and didn't create any lag time or echoing. At the same time, you are able to maintain your situational awareness. The comfort of the X-62000 was incredible. One of our operators wore it for an extended amount of time and even made the comment that he forgot he was even wearing it. The quality and design was also very impressive from the main headset to the X-63700 push to talk. The X-62000 seems to be less cumbersome than the conventional ear muff style tactical headsets. During our training, we also tried other basic swat skills like mechanical breaching, low crawling, shooting from the prone position, etc. The X-62000 stayed in place and did not need to be adjusted due to operator movement. Ironically, at the time of this T&E of the X-62000, our team is in the process evaluating tactical headsets system. Our experience with the Xacore products all but solidified our choice. Overall, I would highly recommend the Xacore X-62000 (and X-63700). In my opinion, it is the most technologically advanced and best tactical headset on the market to date.
