

Pulaski Critical Response Team in Kentucky Selects Threat4's x-62000 Headset

December 23, 2011 – Pulaski County Sheriff's Department in Somerset, KY has chosen the new communication headset from Threat4. The x-62000 headset has a patented 4 microphone system to provide near 360 degree situational awareness, while providing a very high level of hearing protection to the officers (32-39dB noise reduction), and unmatched sound localization. This headset is already fielded by the Kentucky State Police SWAT team, and will now be the communication headset of choice for the Sheriff Department's CRT (Critical Response Team) as well. "Our new headset has been generating great feedback and interest from law enforcement in the great state of Kentucky, and we should have more big news to announce regarding that any day now." said Threat4 Director of Sales Tim Paquette.
